

LUNG CANCER CAUSES MORE DEATHS IN THE UNITED STATES
THAN ANY OTHER TYPE OF CANCER. OFTEN, EARLY LUNG CANCER
DOES NOT CAUSE SYMPTOMS AND CAN GO UNDIAGNOSED.

If you smoke or have smoked, you are at higher risk for lung cancer. Having a screening may help detect the cancer at an earlier stage when it is easier to treat. It could save your life!

Who is eligible for Low Dose CT lung screening?

- Individuals between the ages of 55 to 80 years old
- Currently smoke or quit less than 15 years ago
- Are or were heavy smokers (20 pack-years the equivalent of smoking 20 cigarettes — 1 pack — per day for a year.)
